



Nopal Family Tree WORKSHOP TITLE

MATERIALS

- 1 sheet of paper
- 1 piece of cardboard
- crayons or colored pencils
- markers
- 1 pencil
- 1 eraser
- glue or tape
- scissors

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Grab your piece of cardboard and a green crayon. Draw a half oval on the bottom to represent the base of your *nopal*. Inside your half oval, write your name and color it in using your green crayon.
2. On a sheet of paper, draw 1 *nopal* pad per family member.
3. Use your marker to write the names of your family members. Color in the *nopal* pads using your green crayon. Make sure to leave some room at the bottom to create a flap.
4. Cut out all of your *nopal* pads.
5. With the name of your family member facing up, fold the bottom of each *nopal* pad up to create a small flap.
6. Evenly arrange your *nopal* pads onto your cardboard. Add glue or tape to the flaps to stick them down.
7. Once your *nopal* pads are glued onto your cardboard, flip them over and begin drawing a portrait of that particular family member on the cardboard.
8. Get creative and decorate your *nopal* by adding any decorations to the surrounding areas.
9. Now your *Nopal* Family Tree is complete!
